


Attendees will be divided into teams, each choosing a unique production name. Teams will participate in activities and challenges relevant to daily topics, fostering collaboration and skill development.

- **Activities:** Hands-on workshops where groups create a short narrative proposal, integrating the day's lessons.




Day 2 – December 2nd: Finance

Topics Covered:


- Crew: Identifying key crew roles and their importance in production.

The final 200 attendees will be required to pay 172.48 ZAR to participate.


